Dwellings

2 bedroom Cabins (5)

These dwellings feature two bedrooms with queen beds, a full bathroom with shower, a fully equipped kitchn, and a spacious living and dining area. All cabins have modern amenities such as grills, firepits, Wi-Fi, Nespresso coffee makers, record players and Alexa. Sleeps 4.



Studio Cabins (6)

These dwellings feature an open floor plan with a luxurious king bed, full bathroom with shower, fully equipped kitchen, and a cozy living and dining area. All cabins have modern amenities such as grills, firepits, Wi-Fi, Nespresso coffee makers, record players and Alexa. Sleeps 2.



Cabin 5 Bunkhouse

This cabin has two bedrooms- one with a queen bed and the other with one queen and two twins. Complete with a full bathroom with shower, fully equipped kitchen, and a cozy living and dining area. All cabins have modern amenities such as grills, firepits, Wi-Fi, Nespresso coffee makers, record players and Alexa. This cabin can also be set up as an event space or group gathering. Sleeps 6.



Dwellings

Airstreams (3)

The Airstreams have either a queen bed or two twin beds and is fully equipped with a bathroom, shower, full kitchen with cooking utensils, dining area, living space and plenty of storage. It includes linens, towels, CampV robes and bath amenities. Airstream sites have a picnic table and outdoor firepit. Sleeps

RV Sites (6)

Hook Up! The RV Sites feature large back-in sites with water, electricity, and sewer hookups. Sites also include a picnic table and firepit. Enjoy access to our bathbouse.

Camping (12 acres)

Camp out! We have a variety of open camp sites scattered throughout the lower part of the property offering fire pits, grassy areas and shade. You can camp river side, pond side or amongst the cottonwood trees. This area has limited electricity and one potable water area.


Pond and Beach Lower V

Unwind and get some sun while chilling on Lake V. You'll usually find a unicorn floating around or a group relaxing on the floating dock. This space is perfect for a campout, BBQ, or pool side scene. Power is available, two Ecozoic toilets are near the pond, as well as a fresh indoor/outdoor shower to rinse off. Potable water is not available at Lower V. Plus, we recently built out two new beaches!

This area comfortably fits two hundred people.







Water Tank Upper V

The open-air water tank is perfect for stargazing, yoga, meditation, sound events and sunset cocktails. The interior of the tank has a beautiful wood floor and is equipped with power outlets. The space holds approximately 25 yoga mats and is accented by a large metal firepit near the entrance.

Main Street + Cabin 9 Porch Middle V

This is an intimate setting located right on CampV Main Street with lights, catering options, community fire pit and a front porch for live music and performances. This is a great space for live music, receptions, outdoor dinners, BBQ atmosphere, outdoor movies and more. This spot has access to the Cabin 9 kitchen, restrooms nearby and power. Accommodates bands, crowds and good times of all sizes.






Explore V

Lower V is dedicated to open camping and water access. Float the river in spring, paddleboard in LakeV, and enjoy the cool shade in front of our Zen Den








Explore V

The middle level of V includes our main office, cabins, tents, and Pavilion. It is also home to the majority of our major art installations.





With many unique sites for activities, gathering, meals, ceremony and reception, we are ready to craft the perfect curated celebration.




